Requirements:

Applicants must be a student or recent graduate seeking/with a degree in geography, GIS, environmental sciences, natural resources, engineering, land use planning or other related field at an accredited college or university.

Example of Duties & Responsibilities:

- Collect geospatial data and information from field sites, including the utilization of global system positioning system (GPS) surveying/mapping
- Conduct analysis of GIS data
- Create, maintain and update UTNG's spatial databases
- Digitize maps and satellite imagery
- Assist with the preparation of maps and related graphics
- May be required to operate Class D vehicles and/or off-road All-Terrain Vehicles (ATVs) to conduct field research or other tasks
