RM-URISA GIS SCHOLARSHIP

The Rocky Mountain chapter of the Urban and Regional Information Systems Association (RM-URISA) is sponsoring a financial award for students using GIS in their studies. Any graduate or undergraduate student attending school in Colorado, New Mexico, Utah or Wyoming is eligible to apply.

RM-URISA will issue three financial awards in 2016 depending on the student's level of study as follow:

PhD Candidates: \$1500

Graduate Students: \$1000

Undergraduate (Degree seeking 4-year or 2-year students with GIS certificate) : \$500

RM-URISA requires the following documents for this award:

- 1) Proof of current enrollment.
- 2) Current transcript (unofficial is accepted).
- 3) Description of your GIS-related project (1-3 pages).

This description should include:

- * Working title
- * Contact information
- * Project goals
- * Description and map of the geographic region of the study
- * Methodologies and technology to be used, and
- * Reasons why you should receive this award

- 4) One letter of recommendation.

All applications must be submitted by no later than October 31st, 2016 at 5:00 pm MST.

Awards will be announced on GIS Day, November 16, 2016.
