

**DEPARTMENT OF GEOGRAPHY**  
**REQUIREMENTS FOR THE MAJOR – GEOMORPHOLOGY & HYDROLOGY EMPHASIS**

Students must complete a minimum of seven (7) courses of Geography required coursework (see list below) plus one (1) upper division geography elective course, in addition to a minimum of six (6) geomorphology & hydrology required and elective courses for a minimum total of fourteen (14) required Geography courses. All courses for the major must be taken for a letter grade and completed with a C- or better.

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT: Students must complete at least 18 credit hours in the Department of Geography at the University of Utah.

ALLIED CREDIT REQUIREMENT: 12 credit hours of allied coursework are also required. These courses will generally be in the student's interest/specialization area and can be done in any of the following departments: Atmospheric Sciences; Biology; City and Metropolitan Planning; Civil Engineering; Computer Science; Geology; Parks, Recreation and Tourism; Philosophy; or any department\*\* in the College of Social and Behavioral Science. \*(Aerospace Studies, Anthropology, Economics, Environmental and Sustainability Studies, Ethnic Studies, Family and Consumer Studies, Gender Studies, Health Society and Policy, Military Science, Naval Science, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology)
